Anantara Kihavah Maldives, an Astronomer's Paradise, Celebrates 50th Anniversary of Man's First Walk on the Moon







On July 20, 2019, Anantara Kihavah Villas will commemorate the 50th anniversary of man's first walk on the moon with 'The Eagle Has Landed Celebration.' The astronomer's paradise, Baa Atoll in the Maldives, is one of the best places on earth to enjoy moon and stargazing. Its proximity to the equator and its non-polluted skies means both hemisphere's stars are clearly visible from the resort. SKY, the Maldives' first and only overwater observatory featuring a research-grade 16" Meade LX200 telescope. The custom-built Ash-dome observatory sits on the roof deck of the resort's Sky Bar surrounded by nothing but open skies and the ocean waves below.

Fifty years ago, Apollo 11 landed on the moon and Americans Neil Armstrong and Buzz Aldrin stepped down from the lunar module onto the surface of the moon, the first humans in history to do so. Although Armstrong was in the Sea of Tranquility, Anantara offers the Indian Ocean.

The resort's resident Sky Guru, Ali Shameem, is a native Maldivian who grew up on an island without electricity, Shameem spent his childhood mapping the constellations. A protégé of Italian astronomer Dr. Massimo Tarenghi, Shameem has spent the last decade observing the stars as a professional astronomer. He shares his passion and expertise of the constellations in weekly star gazing experiences for the resort's guests.

4:00 A.M. STAR GAZING BREAKFAST

Lay back to gaze at the stars that glitter overhead, and be regaled by SKY Guru and resident astronomer, Ali Shameem. Take a look through the powerful telescope at the craters on the moon, Orion nebula and Pleiades, commonly known as seven sisters.

Stargazing Breakfast offers guests a unique chance to see the stars in perfect view and greater clarity as the humidity and light pollution are at its minimum during this time. Indulge in a four-course breakfast of chilled Champagne and lobster benedict to accompany your once-in-a-lifetime experience. The price for the experience including breakfast is USD 450 per person.

THE 'BUZZ' ALDRIN (SIGNATURE COCKTAIL)

THE SKY BAR

The panorama luxury cocktail lounge perched over the lagoon maximises ocean views from every vantage point. Contemporary yet warm, with raw timber and soft lighting throughout, this is the place to take in Indian Ocean sunsets. A circular bar serves as the centrepiece, with bar tenders busy at work.

THE SKY OVERWATER OBSERVATORY

The custom-built Ash-dome observatory sits on the roof deck of the Sky Bar surrounded by nothing but open skies and the ocean waves below. The observatory houses a research-grade Meade 16" LX200 telescope mounted on a super-giant field tripod. Digitally controlled with 360° movement, the powerful telescope opens up the night sky.

STARGAZING WITH SKY GURU, ALI SHAMEEM

Sip champagne and savour Asian tapas whilst Sky Guru Ali Shameem points out Sirius, the brightest star in the night sky, Arcturus, Capella, Spica and Omega Centauri, the brightest and largest known globular cluster in the Milky Way galaxy. Take a look through the powerful telescope at the craters on the moon, the belts of Jupiter and the pale-yellow rings of Saturn.
